ranks (assistant, associate, and full). The Department and College support faculty through opportunities for interprofessional collaborations and professional development.

The primary responsibilities of this position are to provide classroom teaching and experiential learning for graduate and undergraduate students in Communicative Disorders and Sciences. The ideal candidate may teach in areas of audiology, speech-language pathology, and/or speech and hearing science. This individual may also play a key role in the day-to-day administration of the undergraduate or graduate program in speech-language pathology or audiology, ensuring teaching and clinical training compliance to maintain our ASHA/CAA accreditation, depending on experience and credentials.
