As a part of a diverse community of faculty and staff who represent many faith systems and worldviews, Marian University seeks a Director of Physical Therapist Assistant Program to promote our Catholic Franciscan mission and identity by being responsible for the start of the Physical Therapist Assistant Associate Degree Program.



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The successful candidate will be a visionary leader overseeing the development and accreditation for the PTA Program. The leader will be responsible for curriculum development, administration and hiring of faculty to support the student and program needs. They will be a key leader in the institution to initiate a new program, increase enrollment and collaborate with all health profession programs on campus.

This is a 12-month, full time, core faculty member holding the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor depending on experience. The appointment will provide administrative release time to carry out the duties of the program director.

- Manage the program budget and ensure all expenditures are made in a fiscally responsive manner.

- Have a minimum of five years (or equivalent), full-time,* post-licensure experience that includes a
 minimum of three years (or equivalent) of full-time clinical experience within any United States
 iurisdiction.
- Have experience in classroom, lab, or clinical teaching experience.
- Have experience in administration, management, and leadership. Experiences derived from the clinic are acceptable.
- Have professional development or education in all of the following: educational theory and methodology, instructional design, student evaluation, and outcome assessment.
- Have experience with CAPTE accreditation is preferred.

Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled. Applications require a cover letter, a current resume, contact information for three professional references, and responses to the supplemental mission questions.
