- Demonstrate a variety of instructional delivery methods, including on-line course delivery
- Establish an independent research program that complements current research in the department. Examples of research areas that complement departmental strengths include, but are not limited to: nutrition, obesity, diabetes, cancer, neuroscience, and metabolic diseases
- Seek intramural and extramural funding, publish in peer-reviewed scientific journals, present research at conferences
- Supervise/mentor undergraduate and graduate students

**SETTING:** The Department of Nutritional Sciences employs 11 faculty members and is an academic unit within the College of Human Sciences. The department offers a baccalaureate degree with program options in Nutrition Science, Dietetics, and Wellness, as well as master, and doctoral degree programs in Nutrition. Opportunities to engage in collaborative research are supported by the Auburn University Boshell Diabetes and Metabolic Disease Research Program, and the Auburn University Research Initiative in Cancer (AURIC). East Alabama Health, and the Edward Via College of Osteopathic Medicine (VCOM) provide additional opportunities for translational research.
