CCS and GCS), clinical experience in the cardiovascular and pulmonary clinical practice area, and previous instructional experience. Contingent upon expertise and interest, additional teaching opportunities may include introductory/pre-professional PT courses, orthotics and prosthetics, pharmacology, and biostatistics, as well as to mentor students in patient care experiences on-campus and in clinical research. Non-teaching responsibilities would include student academic advising, participating in departmental and college-wide committees, clinical practice, and ongoing scholarly productivity within a related field.
