Since its founding in 1998, the Texas A&M School of Public Health has attained national distinction and international recognition. The school enrolls 578 undergraduate majors and 563 minors, 312 master's students and 51 doctoral students taught by more than 60 faculty spanning four departments. Students take courses at the College Station campus and the Higher Education Center at McAllen, and a number of courses are available online. The school is annually ranked among the top five schools of public health in terms of student diversity according to the Association of Schools and Programs of Public Health.

In partnership with department chairs and other school leaders, the next dean of the School of Public Health will develop strategies to recruit and retain diverse, exceptional faculty and staff, and to attract and ensure the success of the highest-caliber students. The dean will be committed to facilitating individual excellence and success, fostering community and strengthening a culture of diversity, equity and inclusion.

The ideal candidate will have a substantial record of relevant scholarship or health practice achievement, strong visibility in the public health research community and/or the capacity to exercise policy leadership at the local, state, national or international levels.

An earned doctoral degree is required. Candidates must have qualifications commensurate with tenure at the rank of professor in the School of Public Health.
