contribute toward a focus of addressing health disparities in underserved populations.

The faculty member will also be expected to engage in quality instruction and contribute to the program's service and outreach with a focus on expanding the psychosocial aspects of exercise, health, and sport curriculum. Instructional roles will include teaching two courses per long semester to undergraduate and/or graduate students in the areas of exercise, health and sport psychology, measurement in exercise and sport psychology, or related area. Service to KHPR, College of Education, University of North Texas, and profession is expected. This may include serving an advisory role in mentored, practical or research experiences, being involved in theses, dissertations, and culminating projects, and serving in committee, curriculum, and coordinator roles.
