funding support for their research, publish research findings, and prepare for a position of national leadership in the field. Teaching responsibilities will include core and/or elective courses in the College of Public Health MPH, BPH, PhD in Health Services Research, and/or MHA degree programs. The service component will include disseminating, translating and applying scientific knowledge for use by academic, clinical, administrative, and policy decision-makers in Kentucky and beyond, and for use by the patients and populations affected by these decisions. The anticipated distribution of effort is Research/Scholarly Activity 65%; Teaching 30%; Service/Professional Development 5%. Faculty distribution of effort is negotiated annually with the department chair and adjusted as needed. Faculty are eligible for a generous benefits package, including health, dental, and vision insurance.

Applicants should submit a cover letter outlining interest in the position, as well as research, teaching, and service experience, along with a current curriculum vitae. Please also include the names and contact information for at least three individuals who can serve as professional references when prompted in the application. This information may be utilized to solicit recommendation letters from your references; however, references will not be contacted without the candidate's consent.
