The Masters of Science in Athletic Training began in 2018 and gained initial accreditation from the CAATE in 2020. It is housed as part of the Academic Health Center (Schools of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences, Dental Medicine, Pharmacy and Nursing) allowing for seamless integration of inter-professional education and access to facilities such as a simulation center. Since its inception, it has a 100% overall BOC pass rate and 100% job placement rate. The program has over 70 clinical
