- Place students in clinical sites and notify students of clinical placement and appropriate contact information.
- Maintain and update documents regarding clinical placement progress and share with course and program coordinators, as necessary.
- Serve as a first point of contact for issues with student placements, manage early intervention of placement needs, and triage as necessary to course and program coordinators.
- Maintain orientation documents for all students enrolled in clinical courses and track student completion.
- Collaborate with Director of Academic Operations to ensure affiliation agreements are in place for clinical sites.
- Attend community of Interest meetings to maintain and build clinical partnerships.
- Assist in tracking requirements necessary to secure student clearances at clinical facilities and access to electronic health records.
- Assist in updating Typhon for accurate listing of all preceptors, clinical sites, and board certifications.
- Notify students of clinical placement and contact information after verification by program coordinator.
- Provide final course hours for preceptor verification and thank you letters.
- Provide graduate clinical staff support with list of students/preceptors/access to appropriate syllabi/evaluative materials.
- Participate in on-site student and preceptor orientations.
