Job Description

The University of Kentucky, College of Nursing Graduate Program is seeking a Special Title Series (tenure-eligible) Assistant Professor. This position is a 12-month appointment with an anticipated Distribution of Effort of about 50-60% Teaching and Advising, 20-40% Clinical Practice Activities, 10-15% Research and Scholarly Activity, and 5-10% Service/Professional Development which will be reviewed annually. The salary range for this position is \$120,000-\$135,000. We anticipate a start date of August 1, 2024.

This position, based in Lexington, KY, onsite, will assist in MSN/DNP program instruction needed to expand and resource the Acute Gerontological Acute Care Nursing (AGACNP) specialty program in the College of Nursing. This position requires an individual to provide teaching, advising, and mentoring related to (a) delivery of care to acute and chronically ill populations in the inpatient/outpatient clinical settings (b) contributing to scholarly practice and (c) advancing nursing professionalism as an advanced practice nurse.
