A terminal doctoral degree (Ph.D., Dr. P.H., or Sc.D.) in a public health discipline or an M.D. with a master's degree from an accredited School of Public Health.

4. Have a significant experience with effectively mentoring faculty in their research efforts.
5. Have administrative experience in an academic setting.
