They should also have a track record of highquality epidemiologic research on population mental health; demonstrated leadership in building and managing multidisciplinary international collaborative projects; expertise in analyzing large and complex datasets; and competence in mentoring early career researchers and research students.

The appointee will play a major role in implementing an interdisciplinary research programme on population mental wellness. He/She will lead and conduct research; write scientific publications, grant proposals and reports; lead and contribute to the planning and delivery of research projects, participate in the planning and delivery of undergraduate/postgraduate programmes; mentor and supervise research staff and students; and contribute to administrative, operational and other duties as assigned.
