Each position is a 12-month, tenure-track appointment at the Assistant Professor rank that begins fall 2025 or earlier.

The Department seeks candidates in all areas of **biostatistics/statistics and data science**. Potential areas of interest include but are not limited to statistical computing, Bayesian modeling, causal inference, clinical trials and analysis of complex large-scale data such as omics data, wearable tech, and electronic health record, with specific preference for candidates whose research contributes to methodology in artificial intelligence. In addition, excellent candidates with other general statistical/biostatistical research topics will be considered and are highly encouraged to apply.

Evaluation of candidates will be based on research productivity, potential for development of an independent research program and capability of teaching. Preference will be given to candidates with experience and/or strong interest in interdisciplinary research. The successful candidate will be expected to develop an extramurally funded independent research program, with emphasis on graduate-level teaching, mentor graduate and undergraduate students, develop interdisciplinary collaborations and engage in service activities.
