We seek a candidate for aClinical Assistant/Associate Professor position in our Undergraduate Program in Public Health. The person hired for this position will have a primary focus on teaching and will make contributions to the scholarship and service missions of the School of Public Health and Health Professions (SPHHP). This is a non-tenure track, academic year (10-month) position, funded by New York State.
