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time position, commensurate with experience, of Associate Professor (Tenured), Assistant Professor (Tenure-track), or Scholar-In-Residence (full-time/term, non-tenure-track); we are especially interested in candidates with expertise in one or more of the following areas: alternative and augmentative communication (AAC), language disorders across the lifespan, and/or audiology/aural rehabilitation. This position is full-time, in-person on our Boston campus. The teaching load may include graduate and/or undergraduate courses, offered on-campus and/or online, as determined by the needs of the department. The appointment begins August 20, 2026 with a mandatory 2-day orientation August 20 & 21, 2026.

We prefer individuals with expertise in Communication Disorders but will consider individuals in related fields. ASHA certification

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and experience with online pedagogy are also strongly preferred. We welcome applicants interested in taking on administrative roles in the short- or long-term.

Associate and Assistant Professor candidates must also submit a research statement. Please provide the names of three references who will be contacted when the applicant becomes a candidate for the position (not to be contacted without the candidate's approval).
