Program Overview: The Department of Speech, Language, and Hearing Sciences is housed in the College of Liberal Arts and has approximately 285 undergraduate majors, 50 graduate majors in speech-language pathology, and 40 doctor of audiology students. Presently, the department has 17 full-time faculty positions. (9 PhD, 3 AuD, and 4 Master's level.) The program offers a Master of Science degree in speech-language pathology with and without a thesis option. The department also offers a professional Doctor of Audiology degree and the Bachelor of Science in Speech, Language, and Hearing Sciences.
